Achievement

- The network of IP has been formed to negotiate with authorities and involved in policy advocacy for promoting IP rights at both local and national level.
- A draft of National IP Council Act submitted to National Legislation Assembly.
- Setting up the IP database system.

Challenges

- No official recognition of the definition of Indigenous Peoples in Thailand and their rights >>> appropriate laws and policies
- Insufficiently access to basic rights (public health, quality education, citizenship, etc.)
- Less participation in development activities including related policies.
- Endogenous development process and strengthening IP's movement
